



in the West Vancouver community and the owner of Marilyn's, which caters to women of all ages and sizes.



Decking The Halls

IT SEEMS THE HOLIDAY SEASON DESCENDS UPON US EARLIER AND EARLIER EACH YEAR. OVER THE YEARS I HAVE FOUND THAT PLAN-NING AHEAD WILL TAKE THE STRESS LEVEL DOWN A NOTCH OR TWO. IT'S EASY TO SET A FESTIVE HOLIDAY MOOD THROUGHOUT YOUR HOME WITH A LITTLE CREATIVITY AND PREPARATION.



- Create your own holiday palette this year by using a colour scheme already incorporated into your décor. Traditional red and green is lovely, but you don't need colour to spruce up your home for the holidays. Consider mixing up a variety of shades and finishes like gold, creams and silvers to create a chic and elegant look.
- Wreaths are a festive and classic way to decorate your home. Mix fresh greens with artificial decorations. Pine cones pair nicely with any colour scheme. Assemble a small, faux, white rose wreath and tie it off with a beautiful white satin ribbon.
- Infuse your home with the beauty of the season with a homemade mistletoe ball. A simple Styrofoam ball is decorated with small, fresh boxwood leaves. Miniature, gold balls are attached on the outside with a glue

- gun. Finish it off with a thin ribbon and hang it outside your front door.
- Set a festive mood throughout your home with beautifully wrapped gifts. Show them off as part of your décor under your tree and by the front door in a basket to get every inch of your home into the holiday spirit.
- Photocopy your favorite holiday tunes on glossy paper. Wrap your recipient's gifts in the musical paper and tie them off with a nice, black velvet ribbon and jingle bell. Alternatively, purchase a pad of honeycomb paper and cut out ornament shapes. Attach these shapes to plain wrapped gifts and use self-adhesive rhinestones and ribbons to finish them off.

Look for baskets and wooden fruit cartons to hide the base of the tree. Not only do these small trees look fantastic but also they will add seasonal colour and scent to any small space.





5 Easy Ways to Spruce Up Your Home for the Holidays

DESIGNERS SHARE THEIR SECRETS SO YOU CAN CREATE THE PERFECT COZY ATMOSPHERE IN YOUR HOME THIS SEASON.

1. CREATE A COZY ATMOSPHERE.

One of Trish Knight's favourite things to do is play with soft textiles. The Homes for the Holidays organizer and interior designer notes that velvets and furs are a particular favourite of hers, and an act as simple as replacing a wool throw with a fur that's warm and inviting invokes cheer.

Homes for the Holidays designer Myriam Freedman loves to use objects from around the house – a favourite piece of china or a deliciously scented candle will do – and bring them together to create a hearth that is an objet d'art. A hot drinks station with cocoa or apple cider completes the feel of the room.

2. LAYER THE LIGHTS.

Strands of winking white or yellow lights are a common sight throughout the holiday season. Knight recommends using bulbs of different sizes to add depth. Consider placing larger bulbs deep within the

boughs of trees, garlands or wreaths and smaller lights on the surface.

3. MIX THE METALS.

Silver, gold and copper play off each other's contrasts. Ditch the combination of berry red and evergreen and incorporate metals to highlight the winter atmosphere outside. White and other soft colours pair well.

4. ADD A BIT OF SHINE.

"You want to create a bit of sparkle, something for the light to catch," says Knight. Something as simple as laying out a few sequined throw pillows will do the trick.

5. INTRODUCE A TOUCH OF WINTER.

Crimson poinsettias are traditional, but our designers favour fresh greenery and, in particular, cedar branches for their earthy smell. "It adds a freshness, a vibrance, a liveliness," says Nicola Varga, Knight's interior design partner. "For me the holiday is as much about the scent as it is about aesthetics," says interior designer Gillian Segal. Warm spices, fresh baked cookies and crisp evergreen adds just as much wintry ambience. With most people huddled away indoors during the winter, Freedman recommends taking cues from nature and reintroducing elements of the forest into the home.

A German Touch

Speculaas

This 17th century spiced Dutch cookie

has some serious crunch. Speculaas,

traditionally baked during the holidays,





a hot cup of cocoa

· 2 cups flour

- · 2 tsp baking powder
- 1/3 tsp ground cardamom
- 1/2 tsp cloves
- ·1 tsp cinnamon
- · 2 eggs
- · 2 drops almond essence
- · 200 g sugar
- · 200 g butter
- · 100 g ground almonds

- Sift the flour, baking powder and spices together into a large bowl, making a well in the centre of the dry ingredients
- 2. Add the eggs, almond essence and sugar to the dry ingredients and mix all together well
- 3. Add the butter and ground almonds to the mixture. When all of the ingredients are combined, remove from the bowl and knead into a dough
- 4. Leave the dough to rest in a cool place or refrigerate for at least half an hour
- 5. Roll the dough into 1/2 cm thickness on a lightly floured surface
- Use cookie cutters to cut the dough into shapes of your choice being careful not to add too much flour
- 7. Bake at 350 degrees Fahrenheit for 10 minutes or until lightly browned
- 8. After letting cool for one minute, remove the cookies from the baking tray and let cool on a wire rack

Vanillekipferl

This nutty, sugar coated crescent-shaped cookie is incredibly easy to make and bake. Popularized and enjoyed throughout Germany during the holidays, it's actually Austrian in origin and pairs delightfully with spiced mulled wine.

·1 cup flour

 100 g ground almonds, hazelnuts or walnuts

1/2 tsp baking powder1/2 cup canter sugar

·1 egg

· 200 g butter

·1 egg yolk

- Mix the flour, baking powder, sugar, cubed butter, ground nuts and egg as per the Speculaas instructions, or combine in a food processor until blended smooth
- 2. When the dough is soft, roll it into a ball or roll and wrap in cling wrap, leave it to harden in the refrigerator for at least two hours, up to overnight
- Remove the cling wrap from the hardened dough and separate into tablespoon-sized amounts
- 4. Shape the separated dough into crescents on a parchment-lined baking tray
- 5. Bake the cookies in the oven heated to 350 degrees Fahrenheit for 10-12 minutes or until firm and golden
- 6. Remove the cookies from the oven and let cool on a wire rack, sift icing sugar over the warm cookies and enjoy







Pop, Fizz, Clink!

SAMANTHA RAHN OF SELECT WINES SHARES HER CHOICE CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINE PAIRINGS FOR HOLIDAY MEALS

The sound of corks popping, champagne fizzing and glasses clinking is symbolic of the time of year people celebrate the holidays with their families. But Samantha Rahn, Select Wines Fine Wine Ambassador and 2013 Sommelier of the Year named at the Vancouver International Wine Festival, believes everyone should drink more champagne and sparkling wine year round because it's an elegant gift and an elegant drink.

"Champagne has always been considered a wine for celebration, but it goes beyond just being a celebratory beverage with festive cork popping and of course bubbles, which everyone loves," she says. "The pairings with holiday foods and just food in general are absolutely limitless."

LIGHT BUBBLES AND BRUNCH

The sparkling French beverage from grapes grown only in the Champagne region, Rahn suggests, can pair with almost any food because of its versatility. Champagne pairs well with holiday brunch, including runny eggs, flaky croissants and other light foods. Rahn's personal recommendation is an Italian Moscato D'Asti, which is light and aromatic, juicy and has pretty flavours like orange blosoms. "You can really enjoy the glass and still have a fabulous day," Rahn says, because its alcohol content is so low. It is also lightly sweet and pairs well with fruits and bonbons.

ROSÉ AND RICH DISHES

However, Rahn recommends pairing the holiday feast with a rosé, which goes down nicely alongside cranberry sauce and stuffing. "Stuffing and rosé is a match made in heaven," she says. Bubbles and the wine's natural acidity also cut through fatty sauces and gravies. A particular favourite of hers, also included in Select Wines' portfolio, is a rosé champagne produced by the 201-year-old family-owned champagne house Billecart-Salmon.


Rahn also incorporates champagne into her own holiday traditions she shares with her husband, who, like her, works in the restaurant industry. The holidays, being the busiest time of the year for both of them, don't leave much time for big celebrations.

For 12 years they've come home from work late at night on December 24, prepared a feast for two that usually includes a decadent cheese plate and a pile of sweets, popped a bottle of champagne and toasted to the holidays in the early hours. "I can't think of a better drink or gift throughout the entire holidays," she says.


